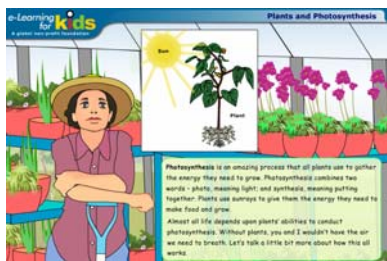


E-Learning for Kids Announces 2 New Courses ... More on the Way!
